Although in recent years I have taken a break as a breeder, kennel Sign Of Constancy was the most successful of the Irish Red Setter kennels in Estonia for many years. Its offspring has been competing at high standards in dog shows and in dog sports. But above all they have been best friends and dearest family members, what is most important.

Besides the Irish Red Setters, I have also owned a Brussels Griffon and a Hungarian Short-haired Pointing Dog. Today I share my home with two Irish Red Setters and one German Shepherd.

I am one of the founding members of the Estonian Setter Club in 1996, where I also was the chairman for many years. A big part of the circle of my good friends are people who have once bought a puppy from me, or who I have learned to know through my beloved hobby. Irish Red Setter breed is my great passion and I really enjoy presenting them at dog shows.

I am very delighted for the invitation to come and judge your lovely dogs in Sweden. It is a great pleasure and a challenge for me to step up in this new role.
